## Seven Habits for Financial Health

Honor the Lord by giving Him the first part of all your income, and he will fill your barns to overflowing! *Proverbs 3:9-10 (TLB)*

The wise man saves for the future, but the foolish man spends whatever he gets. *Proverbs 21:20 (TLB)*

Money that comes easily disappears quickly, but money that is gathered little by little will grow. *Proverbs 13:11 (NCV)*

Develop your business first before building your house. *Proverbs 24:27 (TLB)*

5. I must set up a \_\_\_\_\_ to get myself out of debt.

Don't withhold repayment of your debts. *Proverbs 3:27 (TLB)*

Let no debt remain outstanding. *Romans 13:8 (NIV)*

6. I must \_\_\_\_\_ my spending.

Plan carefully and you will have plenty; if you act too quickly, you will never have enough.

Stupid people spend their money as fast as they get it. *Proverbs 21:20b (TEV)*

7. I must \_\_\_\_\_ what I have.

Godliness with contentment is great gain. *1 Timothy 6:6 (NIV)*

It is better to be satisfied with what you have than to be always wanting something else.

Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for God has said, I will never leave you nor forsake you.” *Hebrews 13:5 (ESV)*
